

Notice to Carriers and Service Providers COVID-19 (Coronavirus) Prevention Measures

Updated March 27, 2020

COVID-19 (coronavirus) is a rapidly evolving world health concern. J.B. Hunt is closely monitoring the health and safety risks presented by the spread of coronavirus, and we are taking appropriate precautionary measures in accordance with guidance from public health authorities. Consistent with the measures we are taking, we are asking third-party carriers, independent contractors and other service and labor providers to review the information below. Please share it with all your employees, contractors, and other team members immediately.

NOTIFY J.B. HUNT AND KEEP PEOPLE SAFE

If one of your drivers hauled a J.B. Hunt brokered load within 14 days of testing positive for COVID-19, please notify your J.B. Hunt representative immediately. Upon receiving notice from you, we will take the appropriate precautionary steps to notify our customers and third parties who may have had contact with the driver. Your cooperation in this effort is an important step to help keep us all safe and critical supply chains open and moving.

FOLLOW CDC RECOMMENDATIONS

The best way to prevent coronavirus is to follow healthy hygiene habits, which are outlined on the CDC's website (https://www.cdc.gov/coronavirus/) under Coronavirus Disease 2019 / Steps to Prevent Illness. It is important to remind all your employees, contractors, and other team members to follow critical prevention measures:

- Wash your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds or use an alcohol-based hand sanitizer with at least 60% alcohol.
- Don't touch your eyes, nose, and mouth with unwashed hands. If you cough, use a sleeve
 or tissue.
- Disinfect high-touch areas frequently with sanitizing cleaners, gels or wipes.
- Stay home when you are sick.

J.B. Hunt has communicated these recommendations to our own employees., and we have implemented certain safety measures for our Final Mile Services delivery teams, including providing hand sanitizer and disinfecting wipes and requiring team members to wear booties and gloves while making deliveries. We encourage you and your employees, contractors, and other team members to take similar measures.

MONITOR TRAVEL AND CONTACT

J.B. Hunt is closely monitoring government travel restrictions and will continue to adjust travel recommendations as needed. Your employees, contractors, and other team members should not



enter J.B. Hunt facilities or provide services for J.B. Hunt or its customers if <u>within 14 days prior to providing services</u> they have:

- 1. traveled to any CDC Warning Level 3 or Alert Level 2 area or country* (currently China, Japan, South Korea, Iran, or Italy); or
- 2. had close contact with, cared for someone diagnosed with or suspected to have the coronavirus; or
- 3. experienced any cold or flu-like symptoms (such as fever, cough, sore throat, respiratory illness and difficulty breathing).

If you identify individuals who must stop providing these services for any of these reasons, please notify your J.B. Hunt representative so that we can take appropriate safety measures.

Please also be aware that your employees, contractors, and other team members may be asked to respond to a visitor safety questionnaire or otherwise answer screening questions when they arrive at shipper and receiver locations.

We appreciate your cooperation and attention to these important safety precautions. Your drivers and delivery teams are vital to our country's supply chain and economy and play an important role in getting much-needed supplies and necessities. Thank you for working hard to keep us all safe and healthy!
